A CUPE National Representative is assigned to each Local. Our CUPE Representative assists our Executive and Committees regarding all Labour Relations issues such as:

- Health and Safety issues and much more!



CUPE Ontario is our Provincial "watchdog" www.cupe.on.ca - manylaws affecting CUPE Members are decided by Provincial Governments. In Ontario, school board funding is determined by the Ministry of Education. Provincial Divisions do not "service" CUPE Locals – the Divisions' role is to lobby, in co-operation with CUPE Locals and "watchdog" legislation and practices of the Provincial Government.

CUPE Ontario is set up in "sectoral groups". We are part of the CUPE Ontario School Board Co-ordinating Committee (OSBCC). Our Area 7 of the OSBCC also includes Durham (both Public and Catholic School Boards), Kawartha-Pine Ridge School Board Peterborough, Northumberland. Clarington and Victoria Catholic School Board.

OSBCC organizes and negotiates our Central Bargaining with the Crown and with the Council of Trustees Association (CTA) representing School Boards.
