We hope to present more workshops in the future.



<u>UPDATE:</u> PROPOSED CHANGES TO YOUR OMERS PENSION

It was reported in our March /April newsletter that OMERS was considering a change to the guaranteed indexing on our OMERS pension and that the Sponsors Corporation (SC) of OMERS would be voting on this at their June meeting.

Many CUPE 997 members along with CUPE members from across the province signed letters and sent them to the OMERS SC letting them know how important the guaranteed inflation protection is for our retirement security. As a result of our letter campaign OMERS has decided not to hold that vote at their June meeting. Consequently CUPE has suspended the letter writing campaign. Copied below is the message now posted on the CUPE.on.ca website:

NOTE: This (letter) campaign has been suspended as the (OMERS) Board has moved away from the original plan to vote on Modified Inflation Indexing at their June meeting.
